HAMBURG – It is with deep sadness that we announce the passing of Dr. Nadine Herrmann. Nadine was the Hamburg office managing partner and Chair of the firm's EU and German Competition Law Practice. She passed away after a serious illness at the age of only 45.

After a stellar academic career, Nadine joined Allen & Overy, where she quickly climbed the ranks and made partner in her early 30s.
